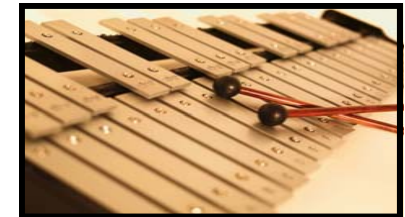

### Marching Band

The Royal Highland Brigade is one of the music programs offered at Royal High School.

The Brigade consists of brass, woodwind, percussion and dance guard. They meet the first semester of school and perform at all home football games, field show tournaments and parades.

In addition to learning music, these students learn a field show and how to march in a parade.

If your program falls between September—January, this band is in session and would love to come over and show you their musical talents!

This is one of our largest band classes.

### Concert Classes

Royal has three levels of Concert Classes (Orchestral Winds, Wind Symphony and Wind Ensemble). Each class contains brass, woodwind and percussion instruments. These groups participate in concerts all year long and music festivals in the Spring semester.

Many of these students have been playing their instruments for 5+ years and would love to show your elementary school students how to properly hold and use their instrument.

### Jazz Band Classes

Royal has three levels of Jazz Ensembles. Each class contains multiple instruments and all students learn jazz concepts, styles and improvisation.

Our Jazz Bands compete in Festivals every Spring.



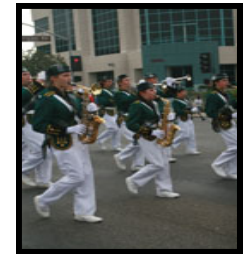
### Winter Drum Line

This group consists of battery (snare, tenor and bass drums) and pit (marimba, vibes, xylophones, bells and chimes), drum set and guitars. This ensemble competes on a gym floor with unique forms of drill and rhythmic music. This class meets from January—April.

### Dance Guard/Winter Dance Guard

This ensemble is the visual aspect of the instrumental music department. The dance guard competes in the fall semester with Brigade (Marching Band) and during the spring semester on the Winter Dance Guard Circuit.

This group uses flags, rifles, sabers and dance for their visual enhancement.
